## Day 1: Monday June 14, 2021



**9.00am** Disembark the Ponant yacht “Le Bougainville” in Palermo and meet our local English speaking guide at the port :enjoy a delightful walk around the streets of **Palermo’s** old town, admiring its landmarks, the Cathedral, the Quattro Canti , the Piazza della Vergogna. , and wander around the Capo open street markets that are a true mix of culture, customs, and food traditions.



**12.00pm:** Transfer to the seaside resort and picturesque small fishing village of **Modello** for an **al fresco lunch at Alle Terrazze.**



Afternoon visit of the **Zingaro Natural Reserve**, one of the most admired natural gems in Sicily: walk along the coastline through white pebbly coves set in a turquoise sea and luxuriant Mediterranean flora.

**Check into our hotel, Baglio Oneto dei Principi di San Lorenzo. A Luxury Wine Resort\*\*\*\*\*** set on top of a panoramic hill, in the most scenic and rich in history and legends of the coast of western Sicily , among green olive trees and vineyards, this enchanted place is our home for the next 2 nights.

## Day 2: Tuesday June 15, 2021



**Breakfast at the hotel.**

**8.30am Transfer with our guide to Selinunte Archaeological Site:**

Part of the Parco Archeologico di Selinunte, this is one of the most



impressive archaeological sites in the Mediterranean, with 2,500-year-old ruins lying on a beautiful high plain overlooking the sea on Sicily's southwest coast near Mazzara del Vallo. Upon entering the park, we can see the impressive Doric temple known as Temple E. Climb into the temple and get an idea of the scale and history of the building. There has been no new development around the site, allowing us to get a sense of the ancient town that existed thousands of years ago.

The visit will include the **Temples of the Oriental Hill and Acropolis.**

**11.30am Transfer to Planeta Ulmo Winery, for a tour of its illustrious vineyards near Menfi, wine tasting followed by a light lunch.**

Nestled at 400 meters above sea level, the vineyard was built in 1995 near the banks of Lake Arancio, on an ancient riverbed whose slope and lime-rich chalky soil ensures perfect drainage and growing conditions for the vines. Indeed, with over 250 hectares of indigenous and international varieties of grapes carefully tailored to the specifics of each terroir, it is no surprise that Ulmo is still the reference for Planeta’s most renowned labels; wines like the company’s signature classic Planeta Chardonnay—a single-variety super cru that has become a symbol for the winemaking renaissance in Sicily—, or the world-famous **Segreta Bianco and Rosso**, named after the woods surrounding the estate.

**Transfer to our hotel with an en-route stop for a guided visit of Mazzara del Vallo, an Arab-influenced old town with incredible architecture.**

**Overnight at our hotel, Baglio Oneto dei Principi di San Lorenzo**

*Dinner tonight is at leisure (not incl.)*





**Breakfast at the hotel**

**9.00am** Transfer along the Northern shoreline to discover the **Salt Road between Marsala and Trapani** and learn the ancient technique of separating the salt from the sea as practiced by Greeks and Phoenicians.

"You will be stunned by an array of landscapes featuring the widest possible range of colors. The green of the Mediterranean scrub, the brown of the patches of earth which at times becomes ochre, the infinite shades of blue in the sea, and the **white of the salt pans of Nubia and Mozia**. There, where the sea meets the earth, you will find the **"Via del Sale"**."



Visit of the lively sea resort, **Trapani**, on the way to the hillside village of **Erice**. Erice is the site of an amazing mountaintop fortress overlooking the sea. It has all the charm of a medieval town, with winding streets, gorgeous flowering courtyards and more than 60 small churches. It also known to be the home of the **Cult of Venus**... Today the town is well-loved for its pastries and other sweet treats.



**We have time to explore the village and some souvenir shopping before lunch on the beautiful terrace of the very popular Elimo Ristorante known for its home-style Sicilian specialties, buffet and panoramic view.**

**Transfer to Palermo and check into our hotel, Villa Igia**

**\*\*\*\***: a turn-of-the-century palazzo at the perimeter of vivid Palermo, the foot of Mount Pellegrino and the Gulf of Palermo. A long-loved seaside-meets-city sanctuary for royalty, dignitaries and Hollywood luminaries...incredible views and tiered villa gardens that sweep down to the port and out to the Tyrrhenian Sea... Totally renovated this year, Villa Igia is the newest jewel of the Rocco Forte collection of luxury properties.



**Rest of the afternoon at leisure.**

**8.00pm** Farewell Dinner at Villa Igia, under the stars and overlooking the Gulf of Palermo



**Breakfast at the hotel, check out.**

**Early group transfer to Palermo airport (PMO), 35 kms from Palermo.**

Please note there are no non-stop flights from Palermo to the USA, however there are multiple flights to connecting international hubs in Europe. This early morning group transfer will allow all of us to meet our various departing flights.
