About Malta

Megaliths, medieval dungeons and Calypso's Cave – The Maltese Islands are positively mythic. The narrow meandering streets of their towns and villages are crowded with Baroque cathedrals and palaces. The countryside is dotted with the oldest known human structures in the world, the Islands have rightly been described as an open-air museum.

The Maltese archipelago lies virtually at the centre of the Mediterranean, with Malta 93 km south of Sicily and 288 km north of Africa. The archipelago consists of three islands: Malta, Gozo and Comino with a total population of 470,000 inhabitants over an area of 316 km² and a coastline of 196.8 km (not including 56.01 km for the island of Gozo).

Malta is the largest island and the cultural, commercial and administrative centre. Gozo is the second largest island and is more rural, characterised by fishing, tourism, crafts and agriculture, while Comino is largely uninhabited.

With superbly sunny weather, expansive coastline and beaches, a thriving nightlife and 7,000 years of intriguing history, there is a great deal to see and do.

Having held the esteemed title of European Capital of Culture 2018, the capital city of Valletta oozes cultural heritage, elegance and nobility. The fortified city, built by Jean Parisot de la Valette, a Grand Master of the Knights of St John, is dense with architectural and artistic examples of a storied past.

True to the melting pot of cultural influences, the national languages are English and Maltese.

Malta Itinerary

Day 1: Wednesday, May 17, 2023

MORNING

We disembark the cruise ship in Valletta and will be met by our guide. Luggage will be dropped off at our 5* boutique hotel, The Cumberland, before starting the tour of this vibrant city. Our guided tour through the colorful streets of Valletta will allow us to discover the beauty and charm of the fortified city built by the Knights in 1566. The Order of St. John ruled over the islands for 268 years and left a unique cultural legacy of which Valletta is the prime example. Enjoy a breathtaking view of the Grand Harbour from the Upper Barracca Gardens. Visit St. John's Co-Cathedral which includes the Caravaggio masterpieces in the Oratory. The Co-Cathedral houses one of the most beautiful marble inlaid floors in the world. Walk past the Grand Masters' Palace and the recently restored St. George's Square before watching the Malta Experience, an audiovisual show where Malta's history throughout the centuries is brought back to life.

Lunch at Rampila, Valletta

Rampila is a unique restaurant situated in the historic bastions of Valletta. The location has a fascinating history. Designed and built by the Knights of St. John in the sixteenth century as part of the defensive bastions guarding the newly constructed city of Valletta, Rampila is now a haven for good food and wine set against a spectacular Baroque backdrop.

3 Course lunch, including half bottle wine per person, water and coffee service

AFTERNOON

The second part of our excursion takes us to the center of Malta, dominated by the medieval fortified city of Mdina, Malta's former capital. The narrow, winding streets, dating back to medieval times, lead to the imposing bastions, commanding a magnificent panorama of the island. On the way there, we discover different styles of architecture, including Siculo-Norman palaces and other baroque buildings of great historical importance. Time stands still in this 'Silent City' which is a film-maker's paradise.

CHECK INTO HOTEL CUMBERLAND

Built in the sixteenth century, this majestic palazzo, a Valletta landmark on St John Street, was converted into a hotel in the late nineteenth century. Its glory days coincided with the island's colonial past in which Valletta was a hive of activity with British servicemen, traders and travelers flocking through its narrow streets.

The property was purchased by its current owners at the turn of the century who undertook the restoration and re-fitting of the hotel, dragging it into the twenty-first century. Whilst respecting all of the original, the hotel now boasts twenty-three uniquely styled and individually decorated rooms and suites.

A peaceful courtyard and magnificent rooftop terrace with expansive views of the Grand Harbour.

EVENING

Dinner: de Mondion

A MICHELIN one star restaurant. Consistently rated amongst the top restaurants in Malta for the soul nourishing cuisine, refinement and excellence, the de Mondion offers discreet and impeccably attentive service allowing its patrons the time and privacy to savour the cuisine, the company and the view.

Malta Itinerary

Day 2 Gozo: Thursday, May 18, 2023

MORNING

After a short twenty-minute ferry crossing we reach Mgarr harbour, which immediately sets the pace to Gozo's unique atmosphere. Our guide leads us around the Megalithic temples of Ggantija, the oldest free-standing monuments in the world, pre-dating the Pyramids of Egypt. This will be followed by visits to the medieval citadel in Victoria, the fjord-like bay at Xlendi and Wejra. Gozo is well known for its crafts, particularly handmade lace and knitted garments. Visitors cannot fail to be impressed by the island's lush countryside, its serene atmosphere and how different it is from the larger island of Malta.

Lunch at Il -Kartell

Steeped in a rich heritage of family, good and honest dining, and a sublime view of the crystal waters of the Mediterranean. Il-Kartell is one of the first standalone restaurants in Marsalforn which has truly been a family affair since its inception in the early 1970s. Despite the minor changes to the landscape, Il-Kartell remains somewhat of a local cornerstone in the world of dining and leisure. The foundations of its kitchen and restaurants are built amongst the original structures of three boat houses that drive the passion to deliver you the very best in casual dining by the sea.

3 Course lunch, including half bottle wine per person, water and coffee service

AFTERNOON

Resume touring the magical island of Gozo before transferring back to Hotel Cumberland in Valletta.

DINNER AT CHOPHOUSE, SLIEMA

Considered to be one of Malta's leading restaurants, The Chophouse boasts a tempting selection of succulent steaks, daily grilled fish and vegan options. They also offer a wide choice of light starters and mouth-watering sweets. Their large glass-fronted 'cave' stocks a selection of well over 300 wines, stored in a humidity and temperature-controlled environment, for optimum serving. They are proud to have been awarded a Michelin Plate, distinguished for "good cooking" and "delightful place"
